# **Sermon Snippets**

Matthew 21: 1-11

As Jesus entered Jerusalem with crowds cheering him and shouting "Hosanna!" people asked "Who is this?"

If we were to ask that question to people outside the church what do you think their answer would be? What about us - what would our answer to that question be? If someone asked us who Jesus is, what would we say?

I think that sometimes we think we need to have all the answers, to know everything, before we talk to our friends about Jesus but that's not true. The people who answered that question on the first Palm Sunday said what they knew (Jesus was a prophet from the town of Nazareth in Galilee). We can do the same - say what we know - and often that begins with telling our story, the story of what Jesus has done for us.

So what would you say? Who is Jesus?

## **Prayer Pointers**

#### Palm Sunday

Praise God today that Jesus Christ surrendered the majesty of heaven and humbled himself and set his face towards the cross. As the crowds laid down their cloaks for him and the shouts of praise went up even then our salvation was his goal. Praise God today!

#### <u>Monday</u>

We pray for families and friends that we have not been able to see for some time. Remember each of them by name before God today.

#### <u>Tuesday</u>

We give thanks for the ministry of Mission Aviation Fellowship and pray for the pilots, ground crews and engineers who ensure that planes fly in order that disadvantaged villagers in remote places around the world are fed physically and spiritually.

#### <u>Wednesday</u>

Give thanks for medical staff who work in hospitals abroad in places of conflict and violence. Pray for their safety and their witness as they seek to bring wholeness and healing in Christ's name.

#### <u>Thursday</u>

In that Upper Room as Jesus washed his disciples' feet, we pray for grace to serve one another as Christ served his friends that day.

#### Good Friday

Be still before God today and think of the cross of Christ and the sufferings he endured; give thanks that on this day he won our salvation. Pray that we might know a little more of what it cost the Son of God to take our sin in his body on the tree.

#### <u>Saturday</u>

As Nicodemus and Joseph of Arimathea came to take down the body of Jesus from the cross and place it in a tomb, we pray for the dying and the bereaved that each one may know the peace of Christ in their hearts in their time of grief.

We will be decorating Emmanuel for Easter at 10.30am on Saturday April 3rd. All are welcome and we hope people will bring plants or arrangements. Baskets for arrangements can be collected at the Good Friday service.
