Prayer Pointers

Monday – Pray that the PEACE of the Lord Jesus Christ may rest in the hearts of all who touch our lives, families, church, community, country, and world.

Tuesday – [P] Pray for PEOPLE with no hope due to personal issues or wider conflicts. Pray for our PARTNERS in mission bringing practical relief by offering help and love in the name of Jesus.

Wednesday – [E] Pray for all struggling with the current ECONOMIC challenges. Pray for all ENEMIES - that we and they may come to know and show the love and compassion of Christ.

Thursday – [A] Pray for all in AUTHORITY, especially those recently elected; that they may serve with integrity and cooperation. Pray for all struggling to find, afford, and retain safe ACCOMMODATION.

Friday – [C] Pray for COMMUNITY activities supporting lonely, vulnerable, disadvantaged, and desperate people. Pray for yourself and place your CONCERNS before the Lord.

Saturday – [E] Pray for the ENVIRONMENT thanking God for the amazing world He has given us and asking for wisdom for all as we try to protect it. Pray for all involved in EDUCATION as learners or teachers. Especially ask for encouragement and concentration for young people taking national examinations, many for the first time.

May the **PEACE** of the Lord Jesus Christ be with us all evermore. AMEN.

SAMARITAN'S PURSE UKRAINE UPDATE

- Recent figures estimate that over 5 million people have fled Ukraine to date.
- Our work has developed into providing water, sanitation, and hygiene items for refugees. These programs are expanding operations to meet increasing needs throughout the country.
- In Ukraine our medical staff are seeing an average of 100 patients daily across five medical sites.
- The DART (Disaster Assistance Response Team) is managing staff and developing partners. In Moldova the DART continues to distribute large amounts of food, hygiene kits, and non-food items to church partners and government centres.
- Refugee counselling and emotional support program content has been prepared and is being translated to serve the psychological condition of refugees.
- Thanks to our supporters, we have delivered aid to over 135,000 people through our response so far.
