Matthew 1: 18-24

Joseph is one of the key Christmas characters and yet we often don't hear too much about him. However, Matthew's gospel does dwell on him a little more and so we're looking at him on Sunday.



One of the things we hear about him is his character. He hears the news that his fiancée was pregnant but not with him and that must have filled him with hurt and possibly anger. And yet he does not press home his rights to publicly shame Mary. Instead, he is kind and treats her with compassion.

Kindness is such a simple virtue and yet one so valuable.
