Sermon Snippets

Christ Church Matthew 5: 1–13

"You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness...". Jesus says we are the people who should have a great positive influence on those we meet during any week – just like salt which flavours and preserves it's surroundings.

It sounds a bit of a contradiction to say "if the salt loses its saltiness..." because there would be nothing left! But the image is one of sea foam where the salt has been leached out and we're just left with 'mush'!!

Today we think of how we can be effective like salt - for God.



Emmanuel Matthew 5: 38-47

Jesus says, "You have heard people say 'Love your neighbour and hate your enemy' but I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who treat you badly. Then you will be acting like your Father in heaven."

Love your enemies? Pray for those who treat you badly? That's a clear command. But it's a hard command! It's hard when we are treated badly. When we have been slighted, mistreated, or spoken down to? It hurts.

So what practical advice does Jesus have?



Our Verse For 2023

Many of us were able to make the "Church Weekend At Home" last autumn where Adrian Youings spoke encouragingly of the lives we live as Christians in the ordinary world of our weeks. We're picking up this theme for our Verse for the Year – which is from Matthew 5 "You are the salt of the earth... You are the light of the world...". The two pictures of salt and light are rich ones where the basic meaning is that both have an effect on their environment – salt mingles with whatever it's put close to; and light naturally shines out onto it's surroundings.

Many of us will have heard talks on this before but may still struggle to put it into practice – how are we to be effective Christians in the places where God has put us? My prayer is that we can all grow in this over the next year – that our friends and neighbours will notice a difference and begin to see God in our lives. It's not easy but I want to encourage you with two things – firstly, God never sends us out alone – He is always with us to give us power and strength – and secondly, we as church family are there to help and encourage each other along!
