Sermon Snippets

Christ Church John 4: 1-42

We are accruing a succession of illustrations to help us think about our Verse For The Year! We've had the Ferrero Rocher to help us remember to be ambassadors for Jesus and we've had the hula hoop, encapsulating everything that Jesus did on the cross, being placed over us – we are brought back to God – reconciled. As Christians we embody Jesus' love and forgiveness in our lives.

We'll continue to think about these two symbols but we'll add the dropped empty bucket, representing our leaving behind what's bad from before we became Christians. We might have changed our thoughts, words, or deeds but we may also have changed how we think about ourselves. Like 'Legion' last month, the

Samaritan woman at the well was an unlikely but powerful ambassador for Jesus.

We might not think of ourselves as ambassadors for our faith but, with Jesus' help, we can help others find their hula hoops so that their lives are surrounded by the love and presence of Jesus too!

Emmanuel Revelation 21: 1-6

'What is the world coming to?' 'Won't the wars ever stop?' Typical questions we may have heard or maybe asked others. Our Father God is oh! so, so patient. But one day He will end this world in a Götterdämmerung of finality. And God will make 'everything new.' Have you been 'born again,' made new yourself, to live in that place with God? Stunning thought to live with God! Indeed this is the purpose of all. Glorifying God in a future existence, whatever that may involve - what an adventure!

But, 'there was no longer any sea' - what does that mean in this strange and mysterious book of Revelation?

Appeal For Prayer

As Christians, when we face something that feels beyond us, what can we do? The Psalms give us a clue – when folk in those days faced real trouble they came to God in prayer. The moods in the Psalms vary from dejected to confident; but, in every case, the issues were brought to God.

Our churches face financial challenges - this is particularly true at Christ Church (with an uplift in heating costs this year and a greater amount requested for us to pay the Diocese). So, can I suggest that we do the same and pray! It is what I've encouraged in the appeal letter and one opportunity is a "drop-in prayer" between 4pm-6pm on Sunday 3rd March, followed by a prayer service of an hour at 6pm where we can pray for all the work at our two churches and our needs too. Prayer Pointers

Monday: We pray for Emmanuel PCC meeting this afternoon - that the Holy Spirit will guide all the discussions and decisions that have to be made.

Tuesday: TearFund are asking us to pray this week for South Sudan, Democratic Republic of Congo, and the Philippines. Today we pray for South Sudan where 9.4 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance caused by conflict, flooding, disease outbreaks, and devaluation of the Sundanese pound. Heavenly Father, we lift these people to you and pray they get what they so desperately need.

<u>Wednesday</u>: We pray for Eastern DRC where there is ongoing fighting. We pray for protection of TearFund staff and their families.

Thursday: We pray for the Philippines recently hit by a huge landslide, triggered by monsoon rains, and efforts hampered by a big earthquake. We pray for access to food, water, shelter, and safety for TearFund's local partners.

<u>Friday</u>: Today we give thanks for the life of Rod Crocker. We pray for Sandra, Sarah, and the rest of the family - asking that the Lord Jesus puts his loving arms around them and gives them the peace that only He can bring.
