## Sermon Snippets

Christ Church Acts 2: 1-21



The story of the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost is dramatic and exciting but it was long ago and we may never have experienced anything like that for ourselves.

Is the Holy Spirit's power in us even if we can't see it? And why was he sent?

We'll think about these questions on Sunday as we come together to celebrate the Holy Spirit and his work in us.

Emmanuel Acts 2: 1-6, 13-21

As we celebrate this Pentecost Sunday we will have completed our 10 days of 'Thy Kingdom Come' prayer and church will begin as a continuation of our 24-hour prayer vigil. We wait expectantly for what the Spirit of God may show this Sunday, and on Monday 20th as we gather for our Vision Day - seeking God's way together. As a church, we are in a place of readiness and anticipation, just like those first believers.

Jesus' followers were all together in once place, as we too are this Sunday, so let us come with expectancy, ready to receive from God, through His Holy Spirit, His fresh equipping for the work He has called us to. Come Holy Spirit.
