## **Prayer Pointers**

Lord, we pray that each one is made aware by you that they are deeply loved, have full experience of your ability to meet the most dire needs, and to know of a Saviour who can give eternal life and security.

SATURDAY: Father God, we give thanks for all those who have ministered to our two churches, including those who have given a word in season perhaps leading to our own salvation and growth. We trust that you have gone ahead of Larissa and her family, anointing her with signs following her future ministry.
