### **Evening Prayer Service** Three Ways Of Using Silence Sunday 9th February at 6pm

People tend to fall into two camps when it comes to talking about keeping a silence in prayer: (1) those who find it really useful and feel we do not give them enough opportunity to use silence in our services and (2) others who feel embarrassed by it, do not know what to do in the quiet, or feel it does not aid their prayer at all.

So, in an attempt to meet both responses, February's Prayer Service will include three different ways to use the quiet. It will not be all silent but will seek to give people who like the quiet a good opportunity. We will also explain how to use those periods and give people who are unsure some different experiences to see if any work for them. We shall try to use silence as praise, silence in intercessory prayer, and silence as listening to God.

One of the aims of these evenings is to help people grow in their

prayer life and this could be a real opportunity for many.
