Prayer Pointers We have just had World Refugee Day but that shouldn't stop us continuing to pray for refugees. In Deuteronomy 10: 17-20, God is taking time to say "I don't show favour. I'm not swayed by

10: 17-20, God is taking time to say "I don't show favour, I'm not swayed by who can buy my love. I care about those who have no one to stand up for them and I want you to do the same. Treat people who aren't 'your people ' with patience, kindness, and respect.

Uganda is host to the largest number of refugees in Africa, and Bidi Bidi is one of the largest refugee settlements.

Tearfund partners are teaching people how to grow mangoes so they can feed their families. Pray for Bidi Bidi and the work of Tearfund's local partners.

Kinshasa in the DRC has been hit by severe flooding. Pray for swift relief, shelter, and healing. We also pray for for local churches and aid workers - that they will be equipped and strengthened to meet the needs.

The world is in a precarious state at the moment. We pray for world leaders - that they will find a way of deescalating the situation. We pray that they are able to talk to each other, hear what others are saying, and come to a way forward that is good for all.

We pray for all preparing services, music, sermons, and prayers for this coming Sunday and that the Holy Spirit speaks to each one of us as we gather to worship in our two churches.
