Isaiah 40: 21-31

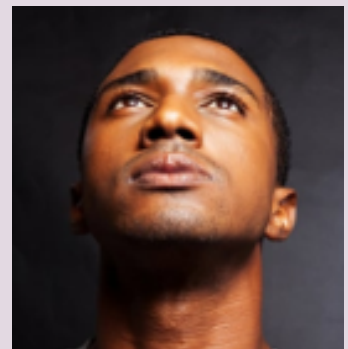
"Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God...". These words were spoken by Isaiah to an Israel in exile. In truth, the Israelites did know and they had heard... but, in their defeat, they'd forgotten. It can be easy when life is busy, or even when we're dealing with disappointment, to take our focus off God and who He is. Perhaps even a little like Israel had?

Our 'Verse For The Year' starts with these words and my prayer is that we'll be encouraged to put God back at the centre of our lives... and, in doing so, to (re)discover the fathomless nature of His energy, strength, and love.

Maybe 2026 is an opportunity for you to do just this? The Diocese is encouraging us to make this year one of prayer... we can use that to pray for our and others needs. But also, I wonder if you might like to use this challenge to spend a few moments each day lifting your eyes to see the wonder of your God? You might like to use some of the verses from Isaiah 40 as a start.

Prayer Pointers

Monday: Today is 'Plough Monday', a tradition performed in farming communities of blessing the land to ensure good soil fertility in the year ahead. Pray for all who labour to provide food for our table. Join with them on this day in asking God for a good year for agriculture, particularly in the light of last year's unfavourable weather conditions that caused so many problems and loss of income for farmers.

Tuesday: Pray for men and woman who, through this year, will have influence on society - for those who frame and administer our laws and, increasingly, those who shape public opinion through social media. Pray that they recognise their responsibility to the country and influence for good not evil, for truth not falsehood.

Wednesday: Pray for God's protection over our brothers and sisters who are refugees or displaced within their own country. Ask for the Lord to be with them and to send the Holy Spirit to give them fortitude as they try to build new lives.

Thursday: This day marks the birth of Martin Luther King. Let us pray that his 'dream' of racial equality and harmony will be achieved. Pray for all like him who strive peacefully for human rights and the freedom of the oppressed.

Friday: Pray for those in countries afflicted by natural disasters, remembering especially Jamaica (ravaged by hurricane in November) and south-east Asia (where there were serious floods last month). Pray for the provision of food, medicine, and shelter for those who have lost homes and belongings.

Saturday: Midwinter is a time of illness and risk of accident. Pray that the Lord will watch over elderly and vulnerable members of our congregations and keep them safe through the winter months. Give thanks that He has brought you yourself safely through this week, and kept you warm, comfortable, and well fed.

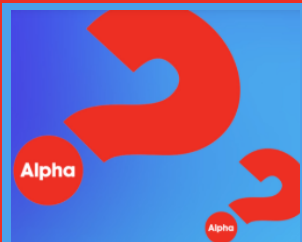
