Come along / tune in to find out.


Michael Beasley, our Bishop of Bath and Wells, is visiting us for two days and he is starting with preaching on this passage. Do come and hear what he has to say!


What do you and I see in Jesus?

Parish Giving Scheme

May I take this opportunity to thank all those who make financial donations to Christ Church. In 2025, donors gave just over £10,000 per month. We also benefit from the Gift Aid scheme through which the church can reclaim the tax that donors (who are taxpayers) have paid, and this brought in an additional £24,000 last year. Our thanks must go to Audrey Flew who manages Gift Aid claims.

A number of donors have switched the method of their giving to the Parish Giving Scheme (PGS). We can use this scheme at no cost - it's funded centrally by the Church of England - and it offers several features that make it attractive.



Both myself, the Treasurer, and Audrey Flew are volunteers in our roles and, if donors switched to the PGS, it would make our lives easier!

The PGS can be used by both taxpayers and non-taxpayers and the PGS manages all Gift Aid claims on behalf of the church, saving considerable work. Donations, which are taken by Direct Debit on the first of each month, arrive in the church bank account in one monthly lump sum which is beneficial to me as Treasurer. Also, donors have the option of setting up automatic annual inflationary rises, but this is optional. The amount donated each month can be changed anytime by making a phone call or accessing your account online. Donations can be anonymous if that is preferred.

I'm asking all current and potential donors to consider switching their giving to the PGS. Twenty donors have already made the switch and these changes have gone through smoothly. Donations can be either for the General Fund or to support Nicky Boardman, our Family Ministry Worker.

Monday

In these countries (as above), many innocent people suffer hardship, lack of food, lack of water, a lack of a reliable energy source, and poor housing. Pray for their wellbeing and that improvements will come.

Wednesday

In this country we have a health service which maybe we sometimes take for granted. Think of those countries which do not have such services or facilities. Pray for people who struggle to get the most basic care and give thanks for our own good fortune.

Thursday

We pray that world leaders will act in a considered way. Not for wealth or territorial gain, but for the welfare and benefit of all people.

Friday

We continue to plunder our world of resources. Over-fishing, destroying large tracts of land for mining of minerals, and destroying habitats. Whilst, Lord, you have given us this world for our use, show us how we can better respect your creation.

Saturday

The situation in Gaza has not gone away. So many are living in temporary accommodation. It is winter and relief aid is not reliable. Pray for relief of the situation and that true peace will come and rebuilding will begin.

To get started on the PGS - please have your bank account details to hand - you can either:

- phone PGS on 0333 002 1271, Monday to Friday, 9am-5pm.

You will need to quote our Parish name: "Weston-super-Mare Christ Church" and our Parish code: 010 601 339. This call usually takes about 10 minutes to complete. PGS will then send you confirmation of your new gift by post or email.

- complete online using [this link](#).



Please note that your first PGS donation will leave your account on the first of the month and it takes a week or so to set things up. If you are an existing donor via a bank standing order, you will need to instruct your bank to end that standing order. If you have any questions on timings or any other aspects of the scheme, please speak to David White or make contact via the Office. If you 'miss' a month's donations between your existing bank standing order and the PGS, David would be happy to take a card payment donation at your convenience!
