A prayer to start -

READ TOGETHER

Introduction to 1 Peter

Peter was probably the first man Jesus specifically called to follow him. Peter's parents had given him the name Simon, but Jesus changed it to Peter (in Greek) or Cephas (in Aramaic). Both these words mean 'rock' in English. At times, it seemed like Jesus had chosen the wrong guy. At times, Peter didn't seem too much like a 'rock' – especially when he denied ever knowing Jesus. (You can read about that in Luke 22: 54-65). But Peter repented of that sin, grew in his faith, and became a great leader and 'rock' of the early church.

Peter wrote this letter to believers who were living in Asia Minor, part of the Roman Empire. They were facing tougher and tougher persecution for their faith. Peter taught them to live as winners on earth, even when it was easy to lose hope. You may not be harassed for your faith, but sometimes you will need encouragement to hang onto the truth.

TALK TOGETHER

PLAY TOGETHER

Catch it!

Find a ball or balloon to play this game inside or outside. Basically, this is a simple game of catch with a twist! As a group, start off spaced out facing each other. There are several ways to play this game to make it harder but to start with one person begins the game by shouting another person's name and throwing them the ball. The game then continues with each player shouting the name of the person they're about to throw the ball to!



To make the game harder with each throw you take a step back, put obstacles in the way, close your eyes, or even if you drop the ball put a hand behind your back or sit down until you catch the ball again! If you'd rather not shout and you can whisper the name of the person you're throwing it to so that you have to listen really carefully to who's being chosen!

Make and design your own flag to show that you are part of God's team – You have been chosen! You can choose whatever design and colours you like!
