



TALK TOGETHER

- ➤ Has anyone ever told you that you were the 'image' of someone in your family? How did that make you feel?
- The Bible says that we are ALL made in God's image. How does it feel to know that God made you to be like him?

STUDY TOGETHER

Genesis 1:27 says that we've been made in the image of God. Nicky said that doesn't mean we look like God but that we're made to show and reflect his character. We're not all-powerful and all-knowing like God but there are aspects of his character that should be seen in our lives.

So, what is God like? Read the following verses and chat/think about how we can practically show these characteristics in our relationships with others and the way we live. Is it easy to be like this? What can help us reflect God's image more?

- Psalm 11:7
- Psalm 25:6
- Psalm 57:10
- > Psalm 103:8
- > Psalm 118:1

All people are made in the image of God but sin has marred that image. When we become part of God's family, he gives us the Holy Spirit to help restore that image to what it should be. The apostle Paul describes it as showing the 'fruit' of the Spirit (Read Galatians 5:22-23).

"For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) and find out what pleases the Lord."

Ephesians 5:8-10

MAKE TOGETHER
'Made in God's Image' Photo Frames




Find a photo of a friend or someone in your family.

Using card from your recycling box, cut out a back for your frame – larger than the photo.

Then cut out a frame for the front, the same size as the back but with a hole cut out, so that you can see the photo! If you are using card that has something printed on it, make sure that is on the inside of the frame. So that you will be able to hang the photo frame up, add some string or wool to the backing piece so that when the front frame is glued down, it will be sandwiched between the two pieces.

Now, using whatever you have available, decorate the front of the frame. In our example, we glued down torn offcuts of coloured paper and wrapping paper. Next, add the title, 'MADE IN GOD'S IMAGE' to the frame. You could also add God's characteristics that you see in the person in the photograph.







PLAY TOGETHER

Pin the nose on the face!

On a large piece of paper, draw a face without a nose (make sure you leave a gap where the nose should be). On a separate piece of paper, draw the nose and cut it out. Take it in turns to be blindfolded (you can use a scarf if you don't have an actual blindfold) and using sticky-tac, try and stick the nose on the face in the right place.

REFLECT TOGETHER

When it's difficult to see God's image...

Think of someone who you find it difficult to see the image of God in and name them quietly in your heart before God. It could be someone who is in the news, a celebrity or someone who is known personally to you.

If you have a photo of them, look at it, otherwise imagine them in your head.

As you sit quietly ask God to show you his image/characteristics in them.

Made in God's Image



When we look in a mirror, we usually do it to make sure we look okay. We might check our clothes or brush our hair if it looks bit messy. As well as checking our physical image, what we look like, why not also check how God's image looks in us.

Write the words 'Made in God's image' on a strip of paper and stick this to the top of your mirror. When you look in the mirror say this prayer:

Father God, I want to be like you today.

Fill me with your love so that I can show everyone what you are like.

Amen

A Prayer of Confession

We confess that although we are made in the image of God, sometimes we ruin God's image by the way we live, by what we say and what we do. Lord, have mercy.

We confess that although we are made in the image of God, sometimes we ignore God's image in others, and make them feel small by our words and actions.

Christ, have mercy.

We confess that although we are made in the image of God, sometimes we hide God's image from others, by pretending that we know best.

Lord, have mercy.

Forgive us, and renew your image made in us, that we may be more like you in living and loving. **Amen.**
