# **International Children's Bible (ICB)**



<sup>12</sup> Later, Jesus talked to the people again. He said, "I am the light of the world. The person who follows me will never live in darkness. He will have the light that gives life."

<sup>13</sup> But the Pharisees said to Jesus, "When you talk about yourself, you are the only one to say these things are true. We cannot accept these things you say."

<sup>14</sup> Jesus answered, "Yes, I am saying these things about myself, but they are true. I know where I came from. And I know where I am going. You don't know where I came from or where I am going. <sup>15</sup> You judge me the way you would judge any man. I don't judge anyone. <sup>16</sup> But if I judge, I judge truthfully. When I judge, I am not alone. The Father who sent me is with me. <sup>17</sup> Your own law says that when two witnesses say the same thing, then you must accept what they say. <sup>18</sup> I am one of the witnesses who speaks about myself. And the Father who sent me is my other witness."

<sup>19</sup> They asked, "Where is your father?"

Jesus answered, "You don't know me or my Father. But if you knew me, then you would know my Father, too." <sup>20</sup> Jesus said these things while he was teaching in the Temple. He was near the place where the money that the people give is kept. But no one arrested him. The right time for Jesus had not yet come.

# **New International Version (NIV)**

<sup>12</sup> When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

<sup>13</sup> The Pharisees challenged him, "Here you are, appearing as your own witness; your testimony is not valid."

<sup>14</sup> Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on my own behalf, my testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going. <sup>15</sup> You judge by human standards; I pass judgment on no one. <sup>16</sup> But if I do judge, my decisions are true, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent me. <sup>17</sup> In your own Law it is written that the testimony of two witnesses is true. <sup>18</sup> I am one who testifies for myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent me."

<sup>19</sup>Then they asked him, "Where is your father?"

"You do not know me or my Father," Jesus replied. "If you knew me, you would know my Father also." <sup>20</sup> He spoke these words while teaching in the temple courts near the place where the offerings were put. Yet no one seized him, because his hour had not yet come.

## Read: John 1:4-5

How did Jesus "shine in the darkness"?

#### Read: John 3:19-21

## **MAKE TOGETHER**

# Jesus is the Light of the World – Lantern or Suncatcher

## You will need:

Baking paper Felt tipped pens Glue or tape Scissors



- \*If making the lantern you will also need, a clean dry jam jar and a tea light candle (battery operated candles are a safe option for young children).
- \*If making the suncatcher you will also need some stiff card to make a frame (something from the recycling box, like a cereal packet will do).

#### Lantern:

Cut a strip of baking paper that will fit around the jam jar.

Draw a colourful design with the pens. You might like to include the words, 'Jesus is the Light of the World' on it.

Glue or tape your coloured baking paper to the jam jar. Place a tea light candle inside and light it. Display it on a windowsill to shine out into the street.

(Don't leave it unattended)

## Suncatcher:

Cut a frame from your cardboard. You can colour it in or cover it in wrapping paper or similar if you like.

Cut a piece of baking paper that will fit the frame: Make sure your paper is big enough to be glued to the back of the frame when you have finished your design.

Draw a colourful design on your baking paper with the pens.

Glue your finished design to the back of the frame.

When it's dry hang it in a window and when the sun shines through it your colours will shine brightly!

## REFLECT TOGETHER



The next time the sun shines through your window, stand with your back to it and look at the shadow you cast on the wall.
