- ➤ Knowing the background of Ezekiel 34, what do you think Jesus is saying to the Pharisees about their leadership of his people?

- What does Jesus mean when he says he is the gate?
- ➤ What does it mean to be saved (v.8-10, also see our verse for the year Jn.20:30-31)
- What does it mean to have life to the full?
